VEHICLE SAFETY CHECKS

A number of CRSP groups have worked closely with RACT to promote vehicle safety checks as part of 'driving to conditions' programs. These sessions allow the community to have tyres, wipers and batteries checked to ensure their car is safe on the road, particularly for winter driving.

The Devonport Mersey Community Care Association adopted a comprehensive fleet safety policy and program aimed at protecting their volunteer drivers. Early in 2010, a series of driver workshops were conducted and ongoing support continues through the provision of generalised road safety messages and campaigns.
