

This checklist will help you to get your vehicle registered in Tasmania.

1. Go to an Approved Inspection Station ([AIS](#)) for an inspection (A [fee](#) will apply). The inspection is valid for 30 days from date of inspection. Note: some vehicles can be conditionally registered and an inspection may not be required.
2. Visit a [Service Tasmania Shop](#) with the following:
 - Proof of entitlement (receipt or entitlement papers)
 - Registration Plates, if any
 - [AIS](#) report
 - Evidence of Identity ([EOI](#))
 - Evidence of Tasmanian [Garage address](#)
 - Payment ([fees](#))
 - Proof of [concession](#), if applicable
3. Apply for refund of unused registration, if applicable (from previous authority refer to interstate papers for contact details).
