**1. Short title**

These regulations may be cited as the *Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Amendment Regulations 2005*.

**2. Commencement**

These regulations take effect on the day on which their making is notified in the *Gazette*.

**3. Principal Regulations**

#### **4. Regulation 11 amended (Eligibility)**

Regulation 11(1) of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting paragraph (b) and substituting the following paragraph:

- (b) has reached –
- (i) in the case of a car licence to be issued as a learner licence, the age of 16 years; or
  - (ii) in the case of a motor cycle licence to be issued as a learner licence, the age of 17 years; or
  - (iii) in the case of a provisional licence, the age of 17 years; or
  - (iv) in any other case, the age prescribed under subregulation (2); and

These regulations amend the *Vehicle and Traffic (Driver  
Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2000* by  
increasing from 16 to 17 years, the age at which a person  
becomes eligible to hold a learner motor cycle licence.
