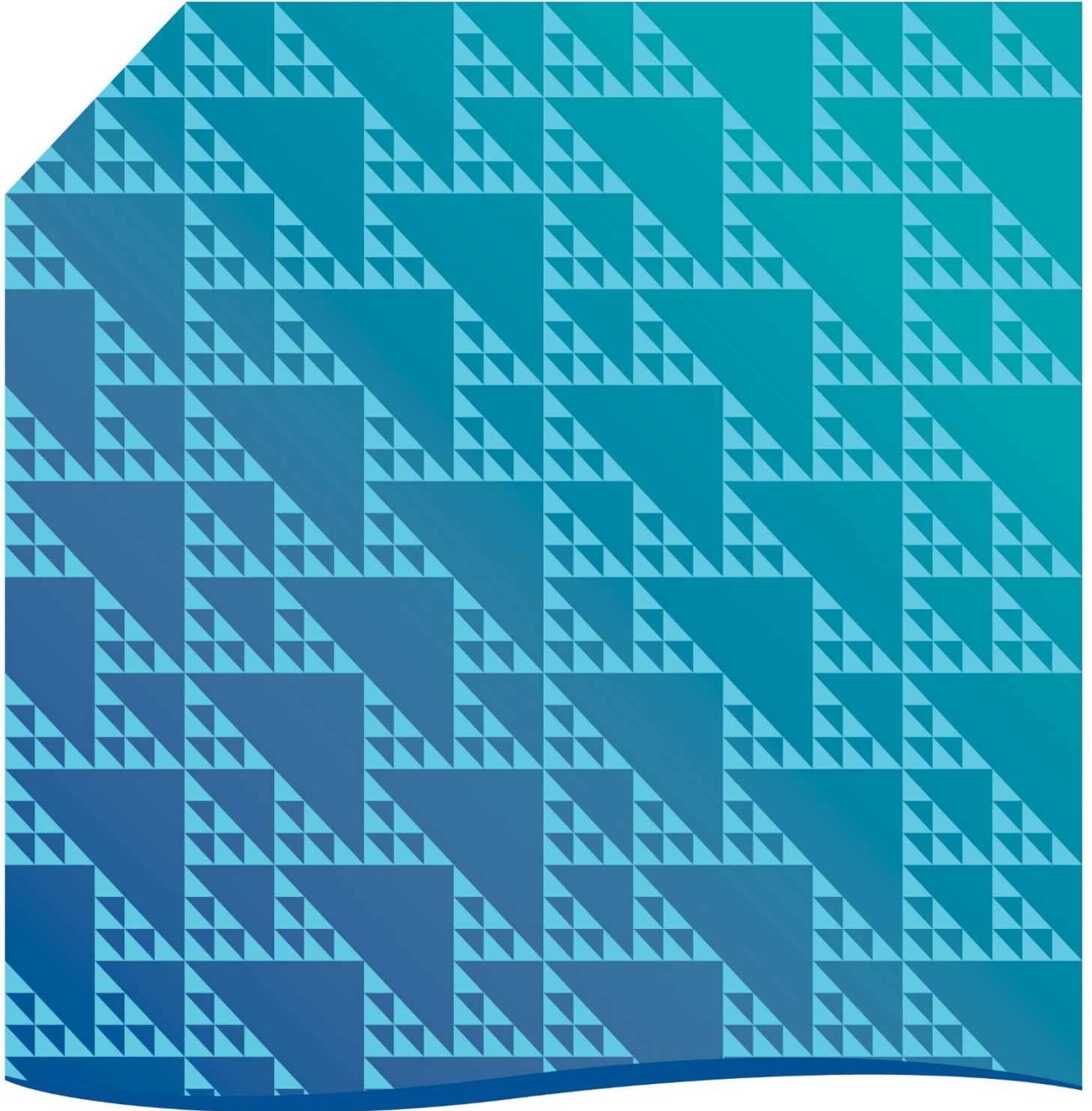

T11.1 Scope

This Specification sets out the requirements for Road Safety Audits.

T11.2 General

Road safety audits shall be carried out in accordance with Austroads: Road Safety Audit including completion of the appropriate road safety audit checklists. Appropriate changes shall be identified and recommended for each section of roadway so as to improve safety.

The audits shall consider all road users, the general public and property, and shall recommend appropriate changes to reduce the likelihood of crashes, the severity of crashes and general damage.

T11.3 Stages for Audit

Audits shall be carried out at project stages as specified in the Brief to ensure either an efficient design and construction process and a safe new road outcome, or to remove problems on an existing road.

T11.4 Audit Reports and Issues Form

A Road Safety Audit Report shall be prepared in accordance with Austroads Guidelines. The report shall include a Road Safety Issues and Actions Form T11-01.
