Exemption Requirements

all applicants must also meet the Registrar of Motor Vehicles suitability requirements to be approved for an exemption

Vehicle	Minimum Exemption Age	Minimum Exemption Period held licence
Light Rigid or Medium Rigid	18 years	No exemptions. You must meet the statutory minimum requirement i.e., have held your car licence (other than a learner) for more than one year.
Heavy Rigid	19 years	Must have progressed to a P2 car licence
Heavy Combination	19 years	Must have progressed to a P2 car licence and held a MR or HR licence for at least 6 months.
Multi-Combination	No age exemptions	Must have held a heavy rigid licence for at least six months and not progressed to a HR or lower class by way of a previous exemption.
