

For the purposes of Conditional (Restricted Use) Registration, the following definitions apply for the listed pre-approved vehicles.

Quad Bike

While generally referred to as quad “bike” they are not deemed to be a motor cycle or bike for the purposes of vehicle registration, licensing or the road rules. A quad bike is an off-road vehicle that;

- is designed to travel on at least four high flotation tyres;
- has a saddle-type seat designed to be straddled by the user; and
- is steered by handlebars.

Note, quad bikes must retain the vehicle safety features provided by the original equipment manufacturer.



Utility Task Vehicle (UTV)(light)

Rough Terrain Vehicle (RTV)(light)

A light utility vehicle is a motorised off-road vehicle that;

- is designed to travel on at least four high flotation tyres;
- has side-by-side seating;
- is propelled solely by either:
 - one or more electric motors; or
 - an internal combustion engine that has a cylinder capacity not exceeding 1,500 cm³;
- has a steering wheel;
- has a tray back designed for carrying loads;
- has an unladen mass of no more than 800 kg;



All-Terrain Vehicle (ATV)

An all-terrain vehicle is a vehicle that;

- is designed to travel on at least four high flotation tyres;
- has side-by-side seating;
- is propelled solely by either:
 - one or more electric motors; or
 - an internal combustion engine that has a cylinder capacity not exceeding 1,500 cm³;
- has a steering wheel;
- has an unladen mass of no more than 800 kg;
- is not designed to carry a load.



Agricultural Motorcycle (Ag Bike)

An Ag Bike is a motorcycle that does not meet Australian Design Rules (ADR) and

- has a solo seat;
- is designed for off road travel;
- has two wheels;
- and is fitted with:
 - an equipment rack;
 - lever guards;
 - dual side stands;
 - clutch lock;
 - indicators;
 - headlight;
 - brake and tail light.



Golf Cart (Golf Buggy)

A Golf cart is a motorised vehicle that;

- Is designed to transport people and equipment around a golf course;
- has dedicated provisions for the carriage of golf bags and clubs for the number of seated persons;
- is designed to travel on at least four high flotation tyres;
- has side-by-side seating;
- is not capable of exceeding 25 km/h on level ground;
- has an unladen mass of no more than 350 kg; and
- does not have road-going features.



Tractor (*Does not include a front-end loader or backhoe*)

A motorised vehicle designed to provide a high tractive effort (pulling force) at slow speeds that is equipped with;

- large rear wheels on the rear of the vehicle;
- centre steering wheel position;
- a rear PTO shaft;
- a rear 3-point linkage system.



Forklift (Does not include a Telehandler²)

A forklift is a motorised vehicle equipped with;

- a vertical mast;
- an elevating platform fitted with a pair of fork tynes (also known as forks);
- rear wheel steering.

² Telehandler (also known as a variable reach truck or multi-purpose tool carrier) means a vehicle equipped with a telescopic boom can be fitted with a range of attachments.



Ride on lawn mower

A ride on mower is a motorised vehicle that,

- is designed to mow large areas of grass;
- is not designed to perform other tasks for example have a loading bucket attached;
- is equipped with an adjustable height mowing deck containing at least cutting blade or blades.



Over Snow Mobile

A motorised vehicle designed specifically for travel over snow that is equipped with;

- a single or pair of skis at the front of the vehicle that provides the mechanism for turning left and right;
- has a saddle-type seat designed to be straddled by the user;
- is steered by handlebars; and
- is driven by a continuous track at the rear.
