The employer’s letter must be on letterhead and state –

- the applicant’s name
- the class of licence the applicant requires to retain their job
- the consequences of the exemption is refused
- where the applicant will be required to drive in the course of their employment
- the purpose of driving the heavy vehicle (eg. Bus, driving, forklift, log truck)
- the hours in which the applicant works
- on average the number of hours the applicant will spend driving that class (& any other class of vehicle) in the course of one work day/shift
- any on-the-job training or additional training that the employer has had will use to train the applicant about driving (the employer should be asked to provide evidence of such training)

PLEASE NOTE: If you have any demerit point offences or other traffic convictions, your application may not be approved.
