

Midway Point bus stop upgrades



Background

The Department of State Growth (State Growth) is currently reviewing bus networks across the state and is improving bus stop infrastructure in Midway Point.

State Growth, in consultation with Sorell Council and Redline, has identified the need to formalise the existing bus stops with bus stop signage and has also identified the need for new stops.

Formalising existing bus stops

Formalising the stops by putting in a bus stop pole and signage is aimed at increasing the awareness of bus services and attracting more people to use public transport. Some footpath improvements will also be made to increase the pedestrian connectivity of these stops. The stops identified for improvement are located at:

- 20 Penna Road
- 36 Penna Road
- 3 Reynolds Road
- Opposite 38 Lake Vue Parade
- 21 First Avenue

New bus stops

It has also been identified that there is a need for two new stops within Midway Point. The proposed new bus stops added to the route will be Disability Discrimination Act (DDA) standard and mean decreased walking distances for residents to their nearest stop. The new bus stops will be located at:

- Opposite 14 Suncrest Street
- 5 Fenton Street
