For your application to be processed at Service Tasmania, you must be able to answer Yes to all questions below and present the following. *

<p>A completed MR48 Ride-source - Application for Ancillary Certificate Must include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> vulnerable people card details on application form <p>If you have declared a medical condition on the form (other than visual aids) you will need to provide a medical at the commercial standards</p>		
<p>Full evidence of your identity <i>refer to Transport Tasmania website for more information</i> https://www.transport.tas.gov.au/</p>		
<p>A <u>Tasmanian</u> driver licence you have held for <u>12 months</u> Or A statement of licence details from another Australian state or territory</p>		
<p>Provide a current National Criminal History Check</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This must be a Nationally Coordinated Criminal History Check (NCC), and Issued within six months of lodgement of your application <p><i>refer to ACIC website for more information</i> https://www.acic.gov.au/our-services/national-police-checking-service/i-need-check-myself</p>		
<p>Provide a passed General Vehicle Inspection Report</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Conducted by Approved Inspection Stations <p>Inspection report must have been undertaken on a vehicle registered in your name. <i>Contact your platform provider if you do not own the vehicle and a completed MR47 Ride source – duty exemption must be provided.</i></p>		

- After you submit your application and all required supporting documents they will be forwarded to State Growth
- State Growth will contact you after 14 days to advise if you are successful
