# **Basemap Gallery**

#### **Add Data**

- Search If you have access to the Web Map Portal in your organisation, you will see all published feature layers in this section that you can add to this web application.
- URL If you want to add a feature class from a different web mapping source, paste the service layer link in the URL box to add the feature class to this web application.
- File If you have an Excel spreadsheet with XY, latitudes and longitudes, you can display the data from the spreadsheet to this map.



#### **Print**

If you want to change the printed map quality, click on 'Advanced' and change the 'DPI' value under the 'Print quality' section.



#### **Bookmark**

Save your favourite bookmark onto the map. Please note that any bookmarks that you save will not be visible to any other user.





#### **Draw**


Select draw mode to draw on the map. You can choose colours, styles and transparency. Your drawing will appear on the map.

## Legend


Select legend to view the symbology assigned to each layer. More legends will appear once you apply more layers.
