

Interstate Transfer checklist to register your vehicle in Tasmania.

1. Have the vehicle inspected at a Tasmanian Approved Inspection Station ([AIS](#)), (a fee will apply). The inspection is valid for 30 days from date of inspection.
2. Visit a [Service Tasmania Shop](#) with:
 - [Proof of entitlement](#)
 - Registration Plates, if any
 - Passed AIS Inspection report
 - [Evidence of Identity](#)
 - Evidence of Tasmanian [Garage address](#)
 - Payment of [fees](#)
 - Proof of [concession](#), if applicable
3. Apply for refund of remaining interstate registration (if applicable) by contacting the interstate registration authority.
